Our journey continues to Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, famed for its Indo-Islamic architectural style. This palace once served as the summer retreat for the Mysorean ruler, Tipu Sultan. The interiors are adorned with floral motifs on the walls, allowing one to envision the leisurely



moments spent by Tipu Sultan in this exquisite setting.

We will then proceed on our journey to Mysore, which is approximately a 3.5-hour drive from Bangalore. Upon our arrival in this city, prepare to be captivated by the renowned city of temples and monuments that have stood for centuries. History enthusiasts, pilgrims, and travelers alike flock here to marvel at the ancient ruins and structures that tell tales of the past.

Following a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on a half-day local sightseeing tour of Coorg, featuring the exquisite Abbey Falls, the revered Omkareshwara Temple, the historic Madikeri Fort, and the picturesque Raja's Seat.

Abbey Falls – Nestled just 8 kilometers from the charming town of Madikeri, Abbey Falls is enveloped by lush coffee plantations and spice estates. Renowned as one of the most stunning



waterfalls in the Coorg region, it plunges gracefully from a height of 70 feet into a serene pool below. A hanging bridge spans the gorge, offering visitors a breathtaking view of the cascading waters. Don't miss the Kali Mata temple located on the opposite side of the bridge. The journey to the falls is adorned with dense vegetation, promising a truly wonderful experience.

Madikeri Fort (closed on Mondays) – Retaining its historical allure, Madikeri Fort stands as one of the most celebrated landmarks in Coorg. A magnificent example of architectural brilliance, the fort also accommodates the Madikeri Fort Museum and the Kote Maha Ganapathi Temple. From its elevated vantage points, the fort offers panoramic vistas of the town, which are nothing short of breathtakingly beautiful.

Sri Omkareshwar Temple – This ancient shrine, dedicated to Lord Shiva, is located in the heart of Madikeri. The temple's unique architecture showcases a harmonious blend of Gothic and Islamic styles, making it a remarkable site to behold.

Raja's Seat – Known as the "Seat of Kings," Raja's Seat is a charming brick and mortar structure supported by four pillars. It serves as a popular viewpoint within a magnificent garden adorned with seasonal flowers and musical fountains. The ideal times to visit Raja's Seat are during the early morning and evening, when one can witness the awe-inspiring views of both sunrise and



sunset. Additionally, a delightful Toy Train attraction is available for children, providing them with a spectacular view of the surrounding mountains.

Subsequently, transfer to Bangalore Airport or Railway Station (267 km / 6 hours) for your onward journey. This tour concludes with cherished memories that will last a lifetime.
