Day Wise Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival in Bangalore and Transfer to Mysore, including a visit to Mysore Palace

Upon your arrival at Bangalore Airport or Railway Station, we will assist you with your transfer to Mysore. After approximately 3.5 hours, we will reach the enchanting “City of Palaces,” where the echoes of ancient monuments and ruins await your discovery. We will check you into your hotel, allowing you some time to unwind before embarking on a half-day sightseeing adventure.



Following our initial exploration, we will proceed to the magnificent Mysore Palace, also referred to as the Maharaja's Palace. This breathtaking three-story royal abode is enveloped by tranquil gardens, once the cherished residence of the Wadiyars. Constructed from exquisite gray granite and opulent pink marble, the palace is a sight to behold. Our journey will also take us to the Jaganmohan Palace, an art gallery established during the reign of Krishnaraja Wodeyar III in 1861. This gallery boasts the largest collection of artifacts in South India. We will also visit the Mysore Zoo (closed on Tuesdays), which was originally founded by Chamaraja Wodeyar X as a private zoo in 1892. It is home to a diverse array of animals and is one of the oldest zoos in the country. Notably, the Mysore Zoo is the only zoo in India to house a Gorilla, along with Chimpanzees and Orangutans. Other exotic creatures residing in the Mysore Zoo include Giraffes, Zebras, White Deer, African Elephants, Bears, Porcupines, Rhinoceros, Tapirs, Otters, and more.

You will have the evening free to explore at your leisure. Feel free to indulge in shopping and take home exquisite silk saris, sandalwood, artifacts, and handicrafts. We will return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 2: A Day of Opulent Sightseeing in Mysore with Brindavan Gardens



Savor your breakfast this morning before we embark on an exquisite full-day exploration of Mysore, the illustrious capital of Karnataka, celebrated for its rich cultural heritage and ancient architecture. Enthusiasts of history and curious minds alike will revel in the opportunity to delve into this city, where tales of yesteryears echo through the majestic structures that stand as silent sentinels of the past, complemented by breathtaking vistas and sacred shrines that radiate a sense of reverence.

Our journey commences at the Mysore Zoo, an expansive 157-acre sanctuary that is home to a diverse array of wildlife and exotic animals. As we approach this remarkable destination, the Chamundi Hills grace the landscape, enhancing the view of one of the oldest zoos in the nation. Notably, it is the sole zoo in India to house a gorilla, alongside orangutans and chimpanzees, making it a favored attraction in Mysore. Families cherish the opportunity to spend quality, educational moments here with their children, introducing them to a variety of animals including giraffes, zebras, African elephants, bears, white deer, tapirs, otters, and many more.

Following our visit to the zoo, we shall proceed to the Mysore Palace, also revered as the Maharaja's Palace, a historical gem that once served as the residence of the Wadiyars. This magnificent monument is among the most frequented sites in Mysore, showcasing extraordinary



architectural marvels and housing remarkable artifacts from a bygone era. Surrounded by lush greenery, the palace is primarily constructed from exquisite grey granite stones and adorned with pink marble domes. A striking 145-foot gilded gold tower majestically overlooks this beloved five-story abode of the Wadiyars.

Our next destination is Chamundi Hills, renowned for its lofty elevation and the sacred Chamundeshwari Temple nestled within. At an impressive height of nearly 3,500 feet, one can relish the breathtaking panorama of Mysore city from above, accompanied by a refreshing breeze and invigorating air. Located approximately 13 kilometers from the city, the Chamundeshwari Temple is a revered Shakti Peetha, known as the Krouncha Pitha, where the hair of Sati is said to have fallen. Here, devotees can worship Shakti in her formidable form as Chamundeshwari!

Day 3: Journey from Mysore to Hassan, with stops at Halebid and Belur

The day begins with a delightful breakfast at the hotel, after which we will check out and depart from Mysore. Our journey to Hassan will include a visit to Halebidu, renowned for the Halebidu Temple, a remarkable testament to the architectural prowess of the Hoysala dynasty. We will



explore the museum, which showcases an array of exquisite statues and sculptures unearthed from the surrounding areas. Just a short distance away lies Belur, a picturesque town celebrated for the Chennakeshava Temple, where devotees honor Lord Vishnu. This temple stands as one of the most exquisite examples of Hoysala architecture, dating back to the 12th century.

Upon our arrival in Hassan, we will continue our drive and check in at the hotel. Enjoy a restful overnight stay in Hassan.

Day 4: Journey from Hassan to Bangalore

Check out from the hotel and make your way to Bangalore, which is also referred to as Bengaluru in Kannada, the capital of the Indian State of Karnataka. This vibrant city is affectionately known as the Garden City.

Day 5: Full Day Local sightseeing of Bangalore



Savor your morning meal and take a moment to unwind until it's time to embark on your journey for the day. We will delve into the charm of this splendid city, affectionately known as "The Garden City," through an extensive tour of Bangalore.

Commence your adventure at the Bangalore Palace, a splendid 19th-century edifice enveloped by verdant gardens in the city's core. This site is a favorite among both locals and visitors, showcasing architectural marvels of a bygone era, with intricate carvings adorning the interiors of its wooden structures. Wander through the medieval castles and uncover the rich heritage of the royal families that once ruled from this magnificent palace.

Next, visit the Sri Radha Krishna Temple, a mere 15-minute drive from the palace, which stands as one of the largest ISKCON (International Society for Krishna Consciousness) temples globally. This grand structure spares no expense in utilizing only the finest materials, including granites, marbles, and glass imported from Korea.

The Venkatappa Art Gallery is a sanctuary for art enthusiasts, boasting a rich collection and stunning architecture. Take a leisurely stroll among the sculpted displays while enjoying the pleasant outdoor climate, or venture into the indoor galleries that showcase at least 600 paintings, some dating back to 2000 BC.



Lastly, the Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum is a key attraction in Bangalore, particularly favored by children for its numerous interactive exhibits. Nestled within Cubbon Park, this museum was inaugurated in 1962 and is dedicated to showcasing scientific and technological advancements, industrial products, and the evolution of engineering. We shall embark on a journey to the Lal Bagh Botanical Garden, a stunning oasis where an abundance of red roses flourish throughout the year. Formerly known as the Rose and Cypress Garden, it is easy to understand why this place is often referred to as 'The City of Gardens.' The Lal Bagh Botanical Garden proudly stands as one of South Asia's most diverse botanical gardens, steeped in history since its establishment in 1760.

Next, we will visit the legendary Nandi Temple, the Dodda Basavana Gudi, also known as the Bull Temple, nestled within the serene Bugle Rock Park. This ancient temple is renowned as the largest Nandi Temple in the world, featuring a magnificent statue of the sacred vahana bull of Krishna positioned just outside the entrance. According to local lore, the land was once fertile, yielding bountiful harvests of groundnuts and peanuts. However, the bull's destructive tendencies became increasingly problematic, prompting the locals to construct a temple in its honor. This act of devotion proved effective, leading to the establishment of a festival known as the groundnut fair or Kadelakai Parase, where the harvests are offered to Nandi.



Our next destination will be the illustrious Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, celebrated for its exquisite Indo-Islamic architecture. This splendid structure once served as the summer retreat for the Mysorean ruler, Tipu Sultan. The two-story palace, crafted from wood, mortar, stone, and plaster, is enveloped by a breathtaking garden. The interiors are adorned with intricate floral patterns on the walls, allowing one to envision the leisurely moments spent by Tipu Sultan in this enchanting abode.

We will then proceed to another architectural marvel in Bangalore, Vidhana Soudha, which was completed in 1956. Soaring to a height of 46 meters, visitors are welcome to admire the external grandeur of this Dravidian-style edifice. Approximately 5,000 individuals contributed to the construction of this striking white-granite building, situated conveniently across from the High Court of Karnataka.

As the sun gracefully sets, you will have the evening at your leisure. Take this opportunity to explore the local department store or enjoy a leisurely stroll through the picturesque city. Perhaps you might visit a pub or two to immerse yourself in the vibrant nightlife that this city has to offer! Overnight stay at hotel.
