Day Wise Itinerary:



Day 1: Arrival in Bangalore and Transfer to Mysore via Somnathpur

Upon your arrival at Bangalore Airport or Railway Station, our dedicated representatives will be on hand to assist you with your transfer to Mysore. Our journey will take us to your pre-arranged hotel in Mysore, but not before we make a delightful stop at Somnathpur to explore the renowned Chennakesava Temple. This magnificent temple was constructed by a general during the reign of Hoysala King Narasimha III in the 1250s. After we have thoroughly enjoyed our visit, we will resume our journey.

As we approach the city, prepare to be captivated by the illustrious city of temples and monuments that have stood the test of time for centuries. History enthusiasts, pilgrims, and travelers alike are drawn here to marvel at the ancient ruins and architectural wonders. We will then check in at the hotel for our overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 2: Royal Mysore Tour Featuring Brindavan Gardens

Mysore, recognized as the cultural capital of Karnataka, boasts remarkable architecture, historical landmarks, temples, and picturesque landscapes. Today, embark on a brief exploration of Mysore city, which includes visits to Mysore Zoo, Mysore Palace, and Brindavan Gardens.



Begin with a visit to Mysore Zoo (closed on Tuesdays) – originally established by Chamaraja Wodeyar X as a private zoo in 1892. This zoo is home to a diverse array of animals and is among the oldest in the nation. Notably, it is the only zoo in India that houses a Gorilla. Additionally, the zoo features Chimpanzees and Orangutans, along with other exotic species such as Giraffes, Zebras, White Deer, African Elephants, Bears, Porcupines, Rhinoceros, Tapir, and Otters.

Next, explore the renowned Mysore Palace (also known as Maharaja's Palace). This historical residence of the Wadiyars is an architectural marvel, showcasing artifacts from bygone eras. The palace is surrounded by meticulously designed gardens. It is an exquisite three-story structure made of fine gray granite, adorned with rich pink marble domes. Dominating the skyline is a five-story tower, standing 145 feet tall, with domes that are gilded in gold. Visitors enter the palace through the "Gombe Thotti" or Doll's Pavilion, which displays traditional dolls from various periods and features a wooden elephant embellished with gold. The kingdom's motto, "never be terrified," is inscribed in Sanskrit on the entrance gate and arch.

In the evening, visit the Krishna Raja Sagara Dam, constructed over the River Cauvery at the confluence of three rivers: Cauvery, Hemavathi, and Lakshmana Thirtha. Be captivated by the vibrant and stunning Brindavan Gardens, celebrated for their symmetrical layout and illuminated



terrace gardens. The main highlight of the Brindavan Gardens is the spectacular display of musical fountains. Enhanced by laser lights, these fountains are choreographed to music and come alive when the gardens are illuminated. Mysore is renowned as a premier shopping haven. Delve into the vibrant local market, where you can acquire exquisite Mysore silk saris, enchanting Mysore sandalwood artifacts and handicrafts, aromatic incense sticks, rich coffee, charming wooden toys, and the traditional Ganjifa paintings of Mysore. After your delightful shopping experience, return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 3: Journey from Mysore to Coorg

Savor a delightful breakfast at the hotel prior to our check-out. Today, we will embark on a scenic 3-hour journey to Coorg. Welcome to “The Scotland of India,” a stunning hill station nestled in Karnataka. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel to unwind. The remainder of the evening is yours to either discover the enchanting surroundings or simply relax in your room before your overnight retreat in Coorg.

Day 4: Full Day Sightseeing Tour in Madikeri with a Visit to Tala Kaveri

Begin your day with breakfast before embarking on a journey to Tala Kaveri, the revered source of the Cauvery River, nestled on the eastern slopes of the majestic Brahmagiri peak at an altitude of 1350 meters. A trek through the Brahmagiri hills offers breathtaking vistas of the surrounding hill ranges, perfect for capturing stunning photographs. Although the steps leading up the hills are steep, they are manageable for those willing to climb. Following this, visit Bhagamandala, located at the confluence of two rivers, the Cauvery and the Kanika, with a third river, the Sujyothi, believed to emerge from underground. Here, you can pay your respects at the temple dedicated to Bhagandeshwara (Lord Shiva) and receive the lord's blessings.

After lunch, proceed to Abbey Falls, situated just 8 kilometers from Madikeri town. This enchanting waterfall is enveloped by lush coffee plantations and spice estates, making it one of the most picturesque waterfalls in the Coorg region. Abbey Falls plunges from a height of 70 feet into a serene pool below. A hanging bridge spans the gorge, providing visitors with a stunning view of the falls. Don't miss the Kali Mata temple located on the opposite side of the bridge. The pathway leading to the waterfalls is adorned with dense vegetation, offering a delightful experience for those who did not visit the previous day.



Next, explore the Madikeri Fort (closed on Mondays), a historical landmark that retains its old-world charm. This fort is a remarkable example of exquisite architectural design and construction styles. It also houses the Madikeri Fort Museum and the Kote Maha Ganapathi Temple. The elevated structures of the fort afford panoramic views of the town, which are undeniably breathtaking and beautiful.

Lastly, visit the Sri Omkareshwar Temple, an ancient shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in the heart of Madikeri. The temple's unique architecture showcases a blend of Gothic and Islamic styles, making it a special site to behold.

Day 5: Journey from Coorg to Ooty

Following a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on your journey to Ooty, a distance of 224 kilometers that will take approximately 6 hours. Upon your arrival, check in to your hotel and take some time to unwind. Ooty, often referred to as “The Queen of Hills” in South India, is perched at an impressive altitude of 2,240 meters above sea level. The renowned Nilgiri Mountain Railway, which links Ooty to Mettupalayam, is celebrated as a UNESCO World Heritage



Site. Enjoy an overnight stay at your hotel in Ooty.

Day 6: A Luxurious Full Day of Local Sightseeing in Ooty

After a delightful breakfast, receive assistance and embark on an exquisite full-day local sightseeing tour in Ooty, featuring the majestic Doddabetta Peak, the intriguing Tea Museum, the serene Botanical Garden, the enchanting Rose Garden, and the picturesque Ooty Lake.

Doddabetta Peak – one of the tallest mountains in the Nilgiris, enveloped by a protected forest and vibrant greenery. Experience a breathtaking bird’s eye view of Ooty from this summit. Visit the telescope house for an exceptional perspective of the surrounding valleys and hills, including the renowned “Chamundi Hills.”

Explore the Tea Museum and discover the fascinating origins of various tea leaves. Marvel at the tea processing techniques employed by CTC (Cut, Twist and Curl) machines and acquire uniquely crafted tea souvenirs. Continue to the Tea Estate View Point to capture photographs, creating unforgettable memories.



After lunch, proceed to the Botanical Garden – an expansive lawn reminiscent of a golf course, ascending steeply with a diverse array of trees and shrubs, alongside conservatories housing exotic ferns and flowering plants. A highlight of this park is the fossilized tree from the prehistoric era, preserved as a natural exhibit. According to carbon dating, it is approximately 20 million years old.

Rose Garden – the largest rose garden in India, showcasing over 20,000 varieties of roses sourced from around the globe. Rare colors such as black and green roses can also be found here. Enjoy a stunning view of the entire Ooty from the Rose Garden.

Visit the Shooting Point – renowned for its picturesque landscapes, frequently chosen by filmmakers and photographers. Ascend a steep hill to reach the main viewpoint, which offers breathtaking vistas of rolling green hills and towering trees. You may explore the surrounding area on foot or horseback.

In the evening, make your way to Ooty Lake – an artificial lake and one of the most celebrated tourist attractions in Ooty. Delight in activities such as boating, cycling, photography, and a mini toy train ride (available on a direct payment basis). Indulge in shopping around Ooty Lake for chocolates, shawls, eucalyptus oil, and more. Finally, return to your hotel to unwind. Enjoy an



overnight stay at your Ooty hotel.

Day 7: Journey from Ooty to Bangalore for Departure

In the morning, following a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on a scenic drive to Bangalore Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey (350 km/8 hrs). This tour concludes, leaving you with cherished memories for a lifetime. Kindly ensure that your flight or train departs in the evening or late evening.
